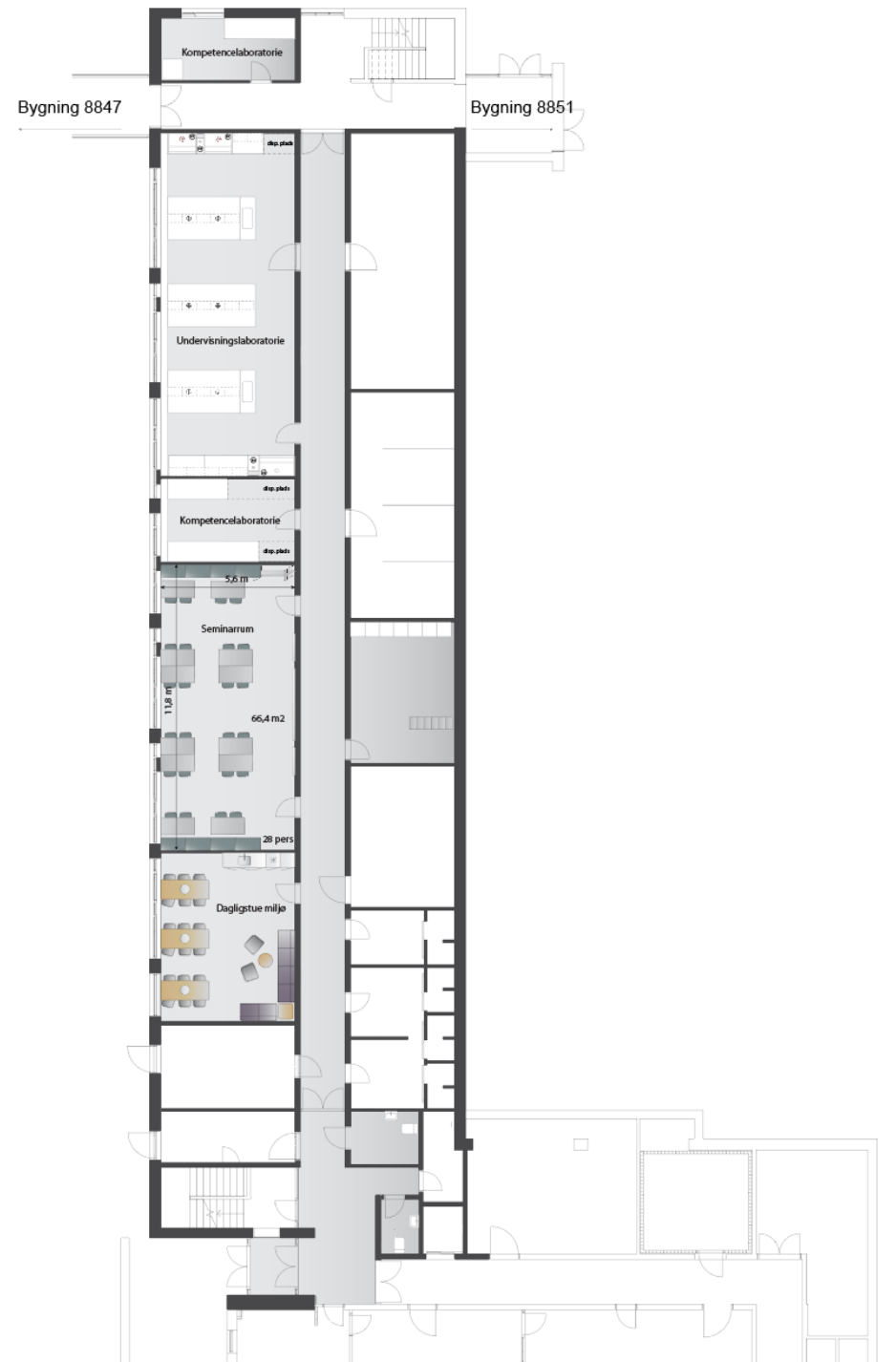

STUDY ENV. – 8841 E1 (C20)

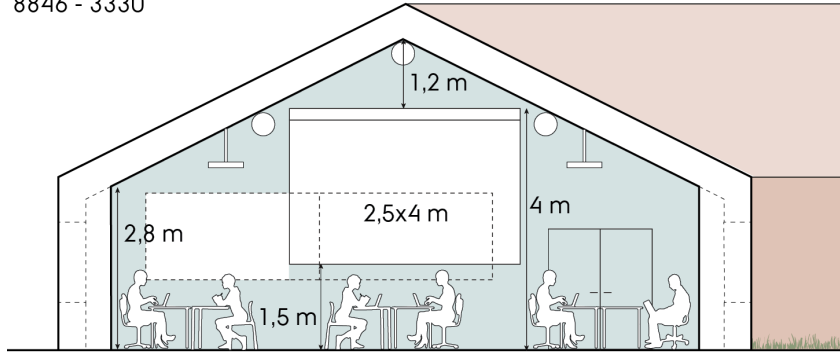


Until the summer of 2024 this seminar room is used as offices for ANIVET. The offices marked as white remain offices.

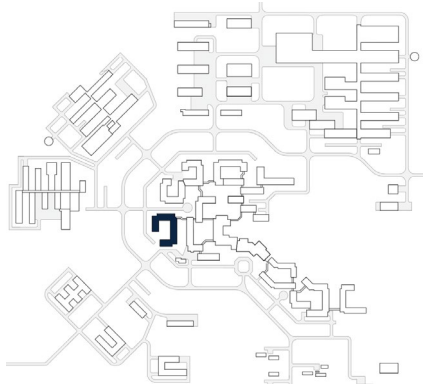

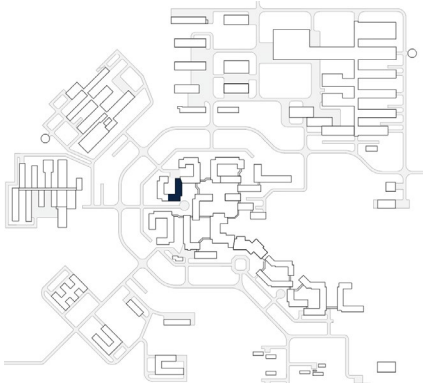

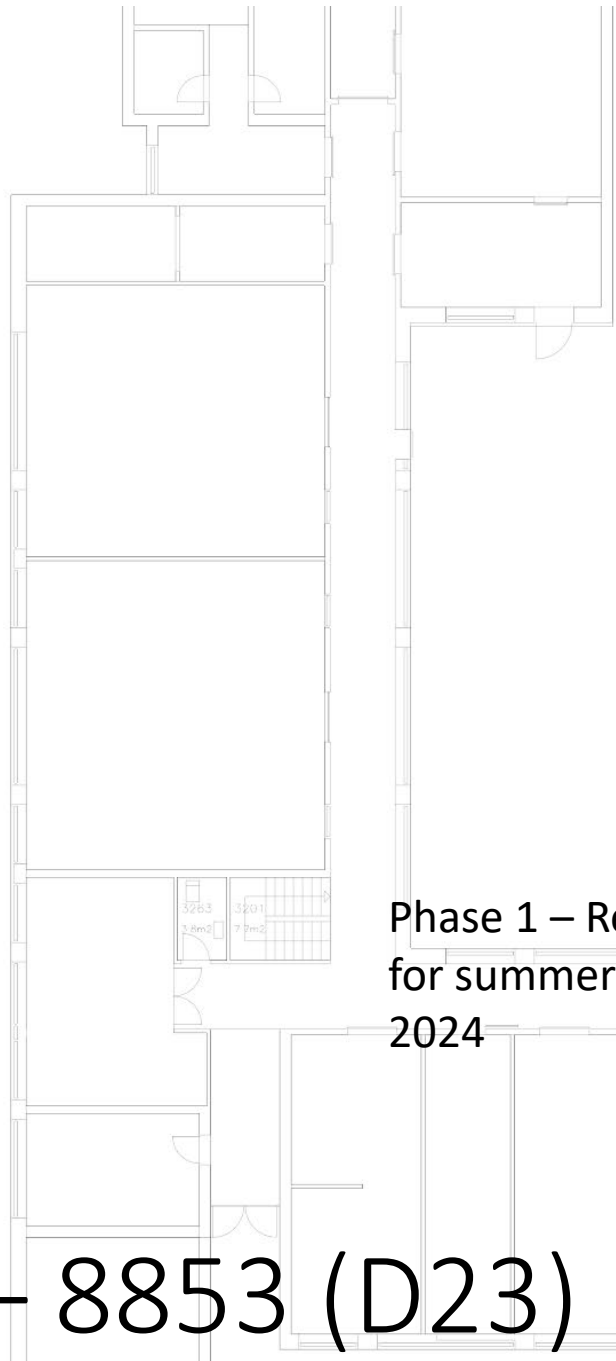
Phase 1- ready summer 2024

"ACCESS CONTROL" AT AU VIBORG – AN OPEN UNIVERSITY CAMPUS

- ADK (electronic card reader) at the outer doors (skaldøre) as it is at present. (At the main building and eventually other study buildings the outer doors will be open during daytime 6-18)
- ADK at labs for educational purposes, (storage rooms, competence-labs) - staff conducting teaching have access
- The needs and possibilities for locks for existing labs / offices are being reviewed
- ADK at facility rooms
- All seminar rooms, group/study/reading rooms are open
- Classified areas – currently in process



MEETING ROOMS

- The meeting rooms by the staff cantine (M3-6) remain bookable meeting rooms
- M2 and the Auditorium will be used for student courses. However, when not in use, the rooms can be used as they are now. And they can be book for events in advance.
- Seminar rooms can be booked for meetings, when they are available. These rooms can be booked in advance through Outlook.
- M1 remains a bookable meeting rooms
